This is of course holy and meaningful connection but how much better to interact and connect BEFORE something might happen. So, if you'd be interested, I'd love to come out sometimes to see you and your loved ones. Let's put something on the calendar!

I pray for a safe and meaningful year for each of you. I pray in these beginning days of the coming year that you can discern a path forward more closely aligned with who you are and who God made you to be, whatever that looks like. I pray that you experience deep and meaningful joy and that the peace and hope of Christ attends you through all that this year will bring.

The Cannon River Church Council met on December 12, 2024 at Cannon River. Present were Pastor Boettcher, Les Anderson, Bill Bodin, David Fremouw, Ellen Anderson, Robert Klahr and Sharon Niebur.

The council meeting was called to order by president, Bill Bodin. Pastor CJ led us in devotions on Luke 3 and prayer.

The minutes from the November14, 2024 council meeting were read. A motion by Ellen Hartman, second by Les Anderson to approve the minutes as written.

The November treasurer's report was reviewed. A motion by David Fremouw, second by Sharon Niebur to approve the report.

Pastor's Report- It was discussed at the last Worship and Music Committee meeting that it would be nice for Cross of Christ and Cannon River to worship together a couple times a year. The first joint worship will be January 12, 2025 at Cross of Christ. The joint service at Cannon River will be in Sept.

- *Send a monthly report to our sister church detailing shared expenses, which they will reimburse.
- *Reports are requested by members and committees monthly and on demand.
- *Monthly pay the state and US treasury payroll taxes and submit quarterly filings.
- *Quarterly prepare and deliver giving statements.
- *Yearly prepare the budget and reports for the annual meeting Prep
- *Work with committees and church council to achieve financial stability.



Financial News:

Missions: Donations of \$955 were sent to Lutheran Disaster response, Hurricane Helene in Nov.

Christmas offerings will be split between the Red Wing, Cannon Falls and Hastings food shelves, unless otherwise designated.

Pastor's **salary** will continue to follow the Synod guidelines, and other staff employees will receive a 3% raise, pending budget approval.

Thrivent members, remember that you can designate your Choice dollars to Cross of Christ, which go to the Building and Grounds fund. Talk to your Thrivent agent for more information. Thanks so much for directing your Choice dollars to Cross of Christ!

In Oct, we took an **early withdrawal** of \$20,000 from one of the CDs to cover the kitchen project down payments. In Dec, we will reinvest the remainder (\$130,000) in another short term CD, and the other CD (\$100,000), along with the earned interest from both, will remain in the money market account.

Rebecca's last day as Treasurer will be Jan. 15. If you know anyone who may be interested in taking over, please speak to someone on council.


Thank you to everyone who filled their tube with coins and brought it

Cross of Christ Council Meeting Minutes December 10, 2024

Present: President Anthony Nemcek, Vice-President Jon Peterson Secretary Deanna Gehloff, Darwin Fox, Jim Gustafson, Jeff Meyer, Sherril Bjornson, Oscar Daley and Pastor CJ Boettcher. Absent: Kelley Mittelsteadt

Meeting was called to order by President Anthony Nemcek and the mission statement was read.

Devotions was led by Pastor CJ.

The meeting agenda was approved, and the November meeting minutes were approved as written.

Unfinished Business

- * Pastor's Report-Pastor will be away Dec. 26-28th in WI and will provide Deanna with a contact for pastoral care while he is out. Pastor will be in touch with Tom on the A/V upgrades and get this project moving forward. Pastor will host an open house on Feb 16th at the parsonage from 12-3pm. Pastor also talked about the possibility exploring other new ministries in the new year including using a resource called "Brewed Theology" and the possibility of meeting monthly in the evenings, at the parsonage. Angie from the Cannon River Inn is interested in hosting a hymn sing at her tavern sometime in the coming months.
- *Kitchen and Bathroom Accessibility Project Update-Jeff noted a start date after the first week in January. It was mentioned roughly 21k was recently donated to the fund.

New Business

- * January Council person: Jim Gustafson- It was noted Jim will need some help ringing the bell.
- * Financial Secretary/Treasurer Position- Rebecca has put in her resignation, and her last day will be Jan 15th. The position has been posted in the weekly updates and announcements, will also be posted on Facebook. Anthony mentioned his sister-in-law was interested. A deadline of Dec. 27th will be added to the posting.

Committee Reports

*Finance

It was noted that the 2025 budget was still a work in progress and will be sent out around Christmas time.

Christmas donations- Motion made and seconded to have Christmas offerings be split between the Cannon Falls, Red Wing and Hastings food shelves. -Motion passed.

Annual employee increases- A motion was made and seconded the recommended 3% increase for Jeff, Rebecca and Deanna for 2025; and to continue to pay Pastor CJ by Synod guidelines with an approx. 6.4% increase for 2025. -Motion Passed.

CD's-A motion was made and seconded the finance recommendation of reinvesting the remaining \$129,887 in another CD, at a rate of 4% for a 6-12/mo term; and depositing the other CD of \$100,000 back into the Money Market account to be available for the kitchen/bath project or other needs.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the financial secretary's reports as written. -Motion Passed.

*Property Management-

The cold weather pushed the repair of the water issue until spring.

- *Worship & Music-Communion will be served for Christmas Eve service, as intinction. Communion/usher help may be needed.
- *Learning & Youth-Sunday school program will be held Dec. 15th with coffee fellowship after. They will be on break until Jan 5th.
- *Service & Witness- "Bring a Friend" to worship as been pushed out due to the Women's retreat.
- *Missions- FMSC M&M tube collection will end Dec. 31st.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. -Motion Passed.

The next meeting will be on January 14 at 6:30pm.
